Purpose: To update the Workers' Compensation billing and payer communities on Rule 16 Utilization Standards and 18 Rule Medical Fee Schedule changes that will be effective January 1, 2010.

The seminar will focus on actual Rule 16 & 18 changes including, but not limited to, professional and facility reimbursements; conversion factors; physician and qualified non-physician telephone calls and on line evaluations; testimony and deposition fees; non-division independent medical exam fees (special reports); impairment rating fees, acupuncture fees, complete revision of payment of medical benefits, new chronic opioid management report fee and new audio recovery fees.

New this year is a Workshop geared toward the new or beginner billing or coding personnel. This workshop will not address the updates to the new Rules.
